

Deliver your "piggy bank" to the Taylor County Extension Office by Friday, January 12th for display and judging.

County prizes will be awarded in the following age categories: K-3, 4-6, 7-8 & 9-12

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Entries must meet the following requirements to be eligible for judging:

- The bank cannot exceed 12 inches X 12 inches X 12 inches (1 square foot)
- Piggy banks must be able to hold coins (i.e., include a slot that has been cut to insert coins).
- Piggy banks must be created or decorated by the youth contestant.
- Plastic or ceramic banks may be used, but must be personally decorated.
- Piggy banks DO NOT have to be in the shape of a pig.
- You MAY use or repurpose other containers.

RECIPE NAME Festive Tree

CURRICULUM TOPIC Grains; Fruits/Veggie;

SETTING REQUIREMENTS Indoor or Outdoor

ESTIMATED TIME Less than 30 Minutes

Cucumber Sandwiches Dairy; Gardening

ACE

INGREDIENTS

1 cup plain nonfat Greek yogurt 1/2 teaspoon dried dill weed

- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder 1/4 teaspoon salt
- Dash black pepper
- 1 small cucumber 8 slices whole wheat bread
- 8 cherry tomatoes



Optional Garnishes: shredded carrots, diced red pepper and shredded cheddar cheese.

DIRECTIONS

- 1. In a small bowl, mix together the yogurt, dill weed, garlic powder, salt and black pepper. Set aside.
- Slice cucumber crosswise thinly into rounds and then each round in half.
- Cut bread into basic tree shape using a serrated knife-or use a sandwich cutter.
- 4. Spread about 2 tablespoons of spread on each slice of bread; top spread with arranged cucumber slices.
- Place a cherry tomato on the top of the sandwich. Garnish each 5. sandwich with shredded carrots, diced red peppers or shredded cheese, if desired.
