


# 2025 TAYLOR COUNTY 4-H COUNTRY HAM PROJECT

- Youth will select, salt, wash, sock, cure, and oil two smoked country hams.
- Youth are required to give a 3-5 minute speech on country hams at the Kentucky State Fair on August 14, 2025 in order to keep their 2nd ham.
- Youth are also required to participate in our County Speech & Demo Contest in March 2025.
