




2025 TAYLOR COUNTY 4-H COUNTRY HAM PROJECT

- Project will meet 4-5 times at Penn's Country Ham (8812 Liberty Rd, Mannsville, KY 42758) or at the Taylor County Extension Office starting March 2025.
- Youth will select, salt, wash, sock, cure, and oil two smoked country hams.
- Youth are required to give a 3-5 minute speech on country hams at the Kentucky State Fair on August 14, 2025 in order to keep their 2nd ham.



REINDEER SNACKS

Ingredients:

- · 3 celery stalks
- · 1/4 cup peanut butter
- 12 raspberries
- 24 raisins
- 24 mini pretzel twists



Directions:

- 1. Cut each stalk of celery into 4 pieces.
- Fill the cavity of each celery piece with approximately one teaspoon of peanut butter.
- Place a raspberry on the end for a nose and add two raisins for eyes.Break pretzel twists to look similar to antlers and add to the top of each snack.
