

(age as of January 1, 2024) Pee-Wee (walking - 5) Novice (5-8) Junior (9-11) Intermediate (12-15) Senior (16+)

General Showmanship Round:

Rabbit, Poultry, Alpaca, Goat (Market & Dairy combined)

Top Showmanship Round:

All 1st Place winners from Novice, Junior, Intermediate and Senior classes return for top showman in each species.

Participants will show the animal they received 1st place with. One overall winner will be selected from each species.

Round Robin: 4 Participants

Top showman from each species competes in final round. Each participant will show in order a Rabbit, Chicken, or Duck. an Alpaca and Goat (Showman Choice- Market or Dairy).

Please note: Rabbit, Poultry and Alpaca are SHOWMANSHIP ONLY. Dairy Goat classes will start following Round Robin Showmanship. Lunch will follow the Dairy Goat Championship Drive. Boer Goat classes will follow lunch (approximately 1:00 p.m.). Market Goats will conclude our show.

If you wish to participate in showmanship with a Boer or Market Goat, please note that showmanship for these will be done with Dairy Goats. You will need to be present and signed up before the Goat Showmanship begins.




Apple Pie Smoothie
