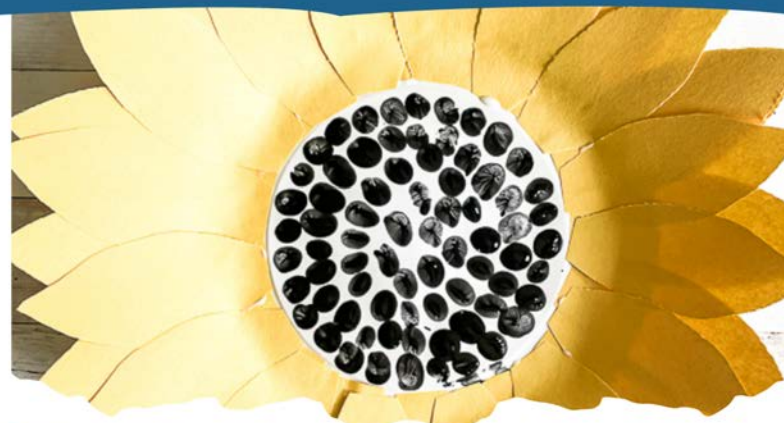

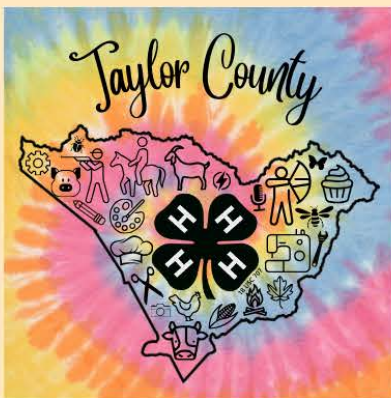

INGREDIENTS

- 16 round whole wheat crackers
- ½ cup hummus
- 48 mini pretzel sticks



DIRECTIONS

1. Spread eight crackers with hummus.
2. Arrange four pretzel sticks on each side of the crackers allowing them to protrude, forming legs.
3. Top with remaining crackers.
